



## 2018 JUNIOR INTERCLUB RULES, 9 HOLE PENNANTS

### 1. ENTRY CONDITIONS

- A. The competition will be played on Sundays consisting of one 9 hole round.
- B. Teams can be made up from U19 players from two Clubs, however players can only play for one team per season.
- C. Each team will comprise four players, boys or girls, any combination of either.

### 2. PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

- A. The player must be a financial member with playing rights at a club within the WGI district.
- B. The player must be under the age of 19 on January 28<sup>th</sup> 2018
- C. No player is permitted to play for two junior interclub teams (in different divisions) in the same round.
- D. Ideally a minimum of two players should hold a handicap. Players without registered handicaps will be allocated the maximum of 18 shots (boys) and 20 shots (girls) for the 9 Holes.

### 3. FORMAT

- A. All matches will consist of a team stableford points competition, with the best 3 of 4 scores counting towards a total score. Match points will be 2 for a win and 1 for a draw.
- B. Caddies are permitted, their role to help with the pace of play and rules of the game.
- C. Team order is determined by handicap index, the lowest index playing in the No.1 position and so on. If two players have the same index the team Manager will decide in which order they play
- D. The number 4 player will tee off first. Boys and Girls both play off the Junior Tees or equivalent.
- E. Pace of play. At the beginning of the round the host club will advise of the expected time of play for the 9 holes. The caddies, parents, caregivers are to help their players towards this recommendation.

### 4. TEAM MANAGER/COORDINATOR

Each individual team is required to have a Manager/Team Coordinator.

- A. Ensure all players are registered on the WGI website.
- B. Enter player names and handicaps into the team sheet on Junior Interclub – 9 Hole Pennants tab on WGI website (<http://wgi.co.nz/interclub/junior>) no later than midday on the Thursday prior to the scheduled match
- C. Print players scorecards on the day
- D. Ensure their team players are eligible to play in this competition.
- E. Ensure the Interclub Team Entry sheet is completed.
- F. Ensure their team is on the tee and ready to play at the designated times.
- G. Collect and check team cards at the conclusion of the round. Cards may be submitted for handicapping in accordance with the “Rules of Golf”
- H. Ensure the Results Sheets are completed and signed by the Team Captain or Manager.
- I. Remain with their team for the duration of the round.
